I. INTRODUCTION

Protecting your privacy is important to us. This Privacy Policy explains how South Central Indiana Rural Electric Membership Corporation collects, uses and safeguards information you provide us from this site. Continued use of our website indicates consent to the collection, use, and disclosure of information as described in this policy.

II. INFORMATION COLLECTED

Like most sites, our server automatically collects certain technical information from your computer and about your connection, such as the URL that referred you to our site, your Internet browser version, and/or type of operating system that you use.
